SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 841

WHEREAS, The Senate of the State of Texas takes pride in recognizing Dr. Charles Agyin Asare of the World Miracle Church International; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Asare was converted to Christianity at the age of 18, and a week following his conversion, he sensed a calling to preach; he was ordained in 1984 and attended All Nations for Christ Bible Institute in Nigeria in 1986, the same year that he was ordained into the office of the Apostle; and

WHEREAS, In 1987, he travelled to Tamle, Northern Ghana, a Moslem stronghold, and established the World Miracle Church International; today there are 57 churches in Ghana, Germany, The Netherlands, and Liberia; the church headquarters are in Accra, Ghana; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Asare was consecrated a Pentecostal/Charismatic bishop in 1991, and has been awarded two honorary doctorates in Divinity and the Humanities; he is president of the World Miracle Ministerial College; and

WHEREAS, A great orator with a prodigious following, Dr. Asare has a radio ministry entitled "Miracle Time" and is a senior pastor of the three-year-old Accra Central Branch, where over 10,000 people attend four different services on Sundays; and

WHEREAS, An inspirational and accomplished theologian, Dr. Asare has preached the Gospel throughout the world; he has preached in the United States of America, the United Kingdom, Israel, and parts of Europe and Africa; his Miracle Encounter Crusades have been attended by more than 80,000 people in a single night; and

WHEREAS, A man of spiritual depth and devotion, Dr. Asare has touched the lives of countless Christians and has provided them with enlightenment, hope, and support; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Senate of the State of Texas, 76th Legislature, hereby commend Dr. Charles Agyin Asare on his fervent service to his fellowman and his outstanding work as an apostle, teacher, and pastor of World Miracle Church International; and, be it further
